Our offer to your school

The YMCA would like to offer your school the opportunity to apply for benevolence assistance for student/s in necessitous circumstances, that would otherwise not have the opportunity to attend camp.

YMCA Camping provides successful applicants with up to one (1) free place for every twenty (20) paying students attending camp.

What are necessitous circumstances?

Necessitous circumstances are those in which a student would need to forego the basics of life – food, water, heat, light, accommodation - should they be required to pay to attend camp.
